You may have wondered why **Royal Naval** bases, like **HMS** *Raleigh*, have ship names. The **Royal Navy** has always been prohibited from ruling over land. So, the **Royal Navy** decided to commission the land as a ship. These are known informally as "stone frigates". The first official stone frigate was a small island off the coast of **Martinique**. In **1803**, the island was commissioned into the **Royal Navy** as **HMS** *Diamond Rock* and was even classed as a "sloop of war". **HMS** *Diamond Rock* even had her own captain and crew!
